FREE TAX HELP!

AARP Tax-Aide

For taxpayers with low- and middle-incomes, with special attention to those age 60 and older.

Please bring the following with you when you meet with our volunteer tax aide:

- Current year's tax forms and preparation booklet
- Copy of last year's income tax return(s)
- W-2 forms from each employer
- 2008 and 2009 property tax statements
- Unemployment compensation statements
- SSA-1099 form if you were paid Social Security benefits
- All 1099 forms (1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B, etc) showing interest and/or dividends and documentation showing original purchase price of sold assets
- 1099-MISC showing any miscellaneous income
- 1099-R form if you received a pension or annuity
- All forms indicating federal income tax paid
- Dependent care provider information (name, employer, ID, Social Security number)
- All receipts or cancelled checks if itemizing deduction
- Social Security cards or other official documentation for yourself and all dependents
