This class will teach potential lifeguards the skills and knowledge to prevent and respond to aquatic emergencies, providing the certifications necessary for employment with the City of Chula Vista as a Lifeguard I. The class includes interview training. Students that pass this class will receive the following American Red Cross certifications: Lifeguard CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED Essentials, and Title 22: First Aid for Public Safety Personnel.
