

GENERAL POOL RULES



1. All persons must obey rules and requests made by Aquatic Staff.
2. Children, ages 5 and under, or under 42 inches tall must be within arm's reach of the parent/adult. Children, ages 8 and under must be accompanied by a parent/adult remaining in the facility.
3. All patrons should walk at all times. Running may result in serious injury.
4. All pool users must take showers before entering the pool area.
5. Food, gum and canned/glass beverages are not allowed on the pool deck. Eating and drinking is permitted in the spectator area. Smoking and glass containers are not permitted in any area of the facility at any time.
6. Non-swimmers or weak swimmers must remain in shallow water areas, no deeper than their armpits. All other swimmers must take a performance swim test with the lifeguard on duty in order to enter deep water areas.
7. Dangerous practices are prohibited at all times. Patrons must not run on decks; climb, sit or jump on fences, equipment, or structures not provided for such activity; dive in shallow water; or swim in diving area.
8. Flotation devices are not permitted during recreational swim, except for U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets.
9. Plastic pants or swim elastic diapers are mandatory for children 3 years or younger or if not toilet trained.
10. All patrons using the pool must wear acceptable swimsuits.
11. Patrons with colds, cough, red or infected eyes, open cuts, sores, infections, or diarrhea within the last 14 days are not permitted to swim.
12. Horseplay, rough housing, fighting, and abusive language are not permitted and will not be tolerated.
13. Use of toys, masks, fins, snorkels, balls, discs and any other throwing or diving items are not permitted during recreational swim, unless provided by aquatic staff.
14. Diving is not allowed except from diving boards and in the 12 ft. section of pool for instructional purpose.
15. Kickboards and pull buoys are to be used during lap swim, instruction, and swim team times only.
16. T-shirts over a suit are allowed; however, large shirts can be unsafe.
17. Animals are not allowed inside the facility, except for service animals.
18. Strollers are permitted in the facility as long as they are against the wall and the wheels are locked. Children must not be left unattended in strollers.
19. Skateboards, scooters, bikes, roller blades, and roller skates are not to be ridden anywhere in the facility.
20. No alcohol, drugs or smoking allowed in the facility.
21. Valuables should not be brought to the pool. The facility is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
22. Proper changing room behavior is required. No photography or videotaping is allowed in the changing rooms. All safety rules apply.
23. Children ages 5 and under may use the opposite sex changing/locker room when accompanied by an opposite sex adult. The child must shower with bathing suit on. Children age 6 and older must use the same sex changing/locker rooms.
