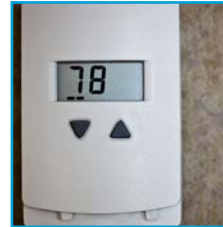
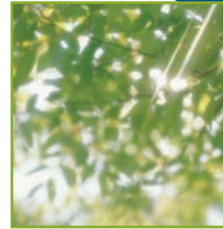

- 3 ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS:**

- 5 KNOW YOUR ENERGY USE.**
Sign up for MyAccount at sdge.com to pay bills online, analyze your bill and view your detailed energy usage.

- Replace traditional bulbs with compact fluorescent lights (CFLs) or light emitting diodes (LEDs).
- Turn off or set timers for lights. Install occupancy sensors to turn off lights when no one is around.
- Minimize “energy vampires” by unplugging devices, turning off power strips, or by using smart energy saving power strips. **Check out a Kill-A-Watt® from your local library branch** to find out how much energy your devices are using.
- Turn off computer equipment at the power source.
- Plant shade trees around your house.
- Set your heater to 68 °F during the day and 55 °F at night.
- Set your air conditioner to 78° F or higher during the day and off during the night.
- Set your water heater temperature to 120° F (140° F with a dishwasher).
- Wash/rinse clothes in cold water and line dry.
- Only purchase highest-rated ENERGY STAR® appliances and equipment.
- Take shorter showers! Five-minute showers save energy and water.
- Use low-flow aerators and shower heads.
