Course Title: **Rope Rescue Technician
CA State Certified**
Course Description: This five (5) day course is designed to meet certification requirements for Rope Rescue Technician. After completion of this course students will take written and skills test on Chapter 5 and Chapter 6 per NFPA 1006 job performance requirements.

This training will include the participant's ability to evaluate, manage, and perform a technical rope rescue as described by NFPA 1006 & NFPA 1670.

- Multi-point anchor systems
- Compound rope mechanical advantage systems
- Ascending and descending a fixed rope
- Fixed rope systems
- Patient pick-offs
- Highline Systems
- Knot passing
- Litter attendants

Textbook and California State Fire Marshal certificate issued. Maximum of 24 students, minimum of 20 students are needed 30 days prior to start date or it will be cancelled.

Category: Technical Rescue Course

Prerequisites: Rescue Systems 1. **A copy of the certificate must be given to the instructor the first day.**
