REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF SIGNATURE FROM PETITION

Background

A voter who has signed an initiative or referendum petition, and who subsequently wishes his or her name withdrawn, may do so by filing a written request for the withdrawal with the appropriate elections official. The written request must include the voter's name, residence address, and signature, and must be filed in the elections official's office prior to the date the petition is filed. (*California Elections Code section 9602*)

Instructions

For City of Chula Vista initiative or referendum petitions, a voter may submit the following information to the City Clerk to withdraw his or her name from an initiative or referendum petition he or she has signed.

The request must have an original "wet" signature. Faxed, emailed, and/or scanned copies cannot be accepted.

The original request for withdrawal must be received in the City Clerk's Office no later than **close of business the day before the petition is filed.**
