

**NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE  
CITY ZONING ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA, CALIFORNIA**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE CITY ZONING ADMINISTRATOR of the City of Chula Vista, CA, has received an application for a Conditional Use Permit, summarized as follows:

**APPLICANT:** Mater Dei Catholic High School  
**SITE ADDRESS:** 1615 Mater Dei Drive  
**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Conditional Use Permit to allow three (3) temporary classrooms trailers for the Mater Dei Catholic High School on a 37.96 acre site. The trailers will be located between the existing gym locker building and the basketball courts. The project site is located in the PC-SF3 Zone (Planned Community) and RLM (Residential Low Medium) General Plan land use designation.  
**ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS:** Planning Staff has reviewed the proposed project for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act and has determined that the project qualifies for a Class 1 categorical exemption pursuant to Section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines. Thus, no further environmental review is necessary.

Any written comments or petitions to be submitted to the Zoning Administrator must be received in the Development Services Department no later than noon on the day prior to the date of consideration. If you wish to challenge the City’s action on this application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised in response to this notice prior to the Zoning Administrator’s action on the application. Within ten days after the decision is rendered, the applicant or other interested person may appeal the Zoning Administrator’s decision to the City Council by submitting an appeal form and the required fee to the Development Services Department. Please notify the project planner if you wish to receive a copy of the Zoning Administrator’s decision.
