Alternative fuels are cleaner burning and less damaging to the environment compared to traditional fuels, which helps to improve air quality in Chula Vista.

Shrink your carbon footprint and pump wisely!

Biodiesel: Biodiesel is an alternative source of diesel that is derived from vegetable oils and animal fats and produces less air pollutants than petroleum-based diesel. B20 is a common fuel blend referring to 20% biodiesel and 80% petroleum diesel.

Compressed Natural Gas (CNG):

CNG is a fossil fuel substitute for gasoline made mostly of methane, which is one of the cleanest burning alternative fuels and is a domestic fuel source.

Electricity: Plug-in electric vehicles are less polluting than gasoline vehicles, because they get their "fuel" from the clean California electricity grid and produce no tailpipe emissions. On average, it costs 3 times less to drive an electric vehicle versus a gasoline vehicle.

Ethanol: An alcohol-based fuel made from corn and other plant-based materials. E85 is a high-level ethanol mix made up of 85% ethanol and 15% gasoline that can only be used in Flexible Fuel vehicles.

Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Propane): A cleaner-burning fossil fuel used to run vehicles that can produce significantly lower amounts of harmful emissions such as carbon dioxide.
