

# LET'S HONOR OUR VETERANS... Brick by Brick!

Veterans Park, a 12-acre community facility and recreation site, is located on East Palomar Street near Medical Center Drive. The park has panoramic views to the west and is close to The Veterans Home of California, Chula Vista.

Veterans Park includes a prominent "Walk of Honor" walkway paved with bricks inscribed with the names of veterans. The City of Chula Vista is making these bricks available to individuals and businesses wishing to honor a veteran.

Each brick bears the name of one veteran, active duty military personnel or reservist and their respective branch of service: U.S. Army, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Coast Guard, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy, Police and Fire Departments.

Brick contributions may be made during our patriotic "Brick by Brick" campaign, held from June 1 to July 31, 2015. All bricks purchased during this campaign will be placed in the Walk of Honor by Veterans Day, 2015.


The minimum contribution for a single commemorative brick is \$100. Walk of Honor bricks measure 4" x 8" x 2.25" and are engraved using state-of-the-art technology that guarantees they will never fade, chip, oxidize or peel.

All net proceeds from the commemorative Brick by Brick campaign will benefit the programs of the Friends of Chula Vista Parks and Recreation, including youth basketball, the Learn to Swim program, and after school hours programming.

**DEADLINES AND INFORMATION**

Brick orders will be taken on a continuous basis until the "Walk of Honor" is filled. Bricks will be placed once the order quantities have been met. You will be notified when your brick(s) have been placed in the "Walk of Honor."

**ENGRAVING INFORMATION**

Each 4" x 8" x 2 1/4" brick can have up to 3 lines of wording, 20 characters per line (characters include spaces and any punctuation plus branch of service (required)).

Please make sure your engraving information is spelled correctly (please print very clearly). Standardized and accepted abbreviations for the branches of service are: U.S. Army; U.S.A.F.; U.S.C.G.; U.S.M.C.; U.S.N.; Police, and Fire.
