On Friday, April 4th, at approximately 2:27 P.M., the Chula Vista Police Department received multiple 911 calls reporting a collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian. The 66-year-old pedestrian is a San Diego resident. She was struck by the vehicle as she crossed the street. The 94-year-old driver and sole occupant of the vehicle was uninjured. The driver is a Bonita resident. The pedestrian sustained serious injuries and was transported to the hospital where she remains in critical condition. The driver remained at the scene and was cooperative with the investigation. Drugs or alcohol are not believed to be a factor at this time.

The Chula Vista Police Department Traffic Bureau responded and are continuing their investigation.
