### Message:

On June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at approximately 12:13 a.m., the Chula Vista Police Department received several calls regarding a single roll-over vehicle traffic collision in the area of 900 Marina Parkway in the city of Chula Vista. Police personnel arrived on scene and discovered a black BMW 335i, traveling eastbound on Marina Parkway, drove off the roadway and hit a concrete pillar. The vehicle flipped several times, causing significant damage to the vehicle. The vehicle was occupied by 4 subjects. Two adult females, (Front and backseat passengers) were taken to the hospital with minor injuries. The male driver and male backseat passenger had to be extricated from the vehicle by fire personnel. Both males were transported to local trauma centers with life threatening injuries. The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau was called to the scene to investigate the collision.

The cause of the collision has not yet been determined. Alcohol is believed to be a factor in this collision. The driver, Blake Todd 08/10/03, was placed under arrest for felony DUI with injury, and released to the hospital for medical treatment. The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau is currently investigating the collision.
