Subject: **FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION INVOLVING POLICE VEHICLE – OLYMPIC PKWY / WINDINGWALK ST *UPDATE - MOTORCYCLE RIDER IDENTIFIED**

***UPDATED BELOW**

At approximately 6:14 p.m., a Chula Vista Police Officer responding to a radio call was involved in a traffic collision with a motorcycle at the intersection of Olympic Parkway and Windingwalk Street.

The officer was turning left onto southbound Windingwalk Street from westbound Olympic Parkway when the motorcycle, traveling eastbound on Olympic Parkway, collided with the side of the marked police vehicle.

The officer was transported to a local hospital for evaluation. The motorcycle rider, a Chula Vista man in his late 20s, sustained severe injuries and was transported to the hospital, where he tragically succumbed to his injuries. His identity is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.

Due to the seriousness of the incident and the involvement of a Chula Vista Police Officer, the California Highway Patrol (CHP) has been requested to lead the investigation.

Media inquiries may continue to be directed to the Chula Vista Police Department. However, as this remains an active investigation, no further details are available at this time.

UPDATED JUNE 24th, 2025: The deceased motorcycle rider has been identified as 28-year-old Simon Robledo of Chula Vista.

On behalf of the Chula Vista Police Department, Chief Roxana Kennedy offers her deepest condolences to the family of Mr. Robledo. Although the investigation is still in its early stages and many answers will not be available for considerable time, the loss of life is never taken lightly by Chief Kennedy or her department.
