Subject: Fatal Traffic Collision – 2000 Block of Tango Loop (Chula Vista) Case # 2509582

Message: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On July 13th, 2025, at approximately 2:14 P.M., the Chula Vista Police Department received a 911 call from an involved party in the 2000 Block of Tango Loop in Chula Vista referencing a traffic collision. Minimal information was given at first, but an additional reporting party called and advised that a young juvenile had been struck by a vehicle and was pinned underneath the front end. Chula Vista Police and Fire Department personnel arrived on scene to assist and render aid. It was quickly determined that the juvenile was riding a stand-up electric scooter. Bystanders assisted by using a rolling hydraulic jack to lift the vehicle to free the juvenile. The juvenile was transported to Rady Children's Hospital, where he was ultimately pronounced deceased a short time later. The Chula Vista Police Department Traffic Bureau responded to investigate. At this time, drugs and alcohol are not believed to be a factor in the collision and there is no indication any other vehicles were involved. The name of the deceased is being withheld pending notification to family members. The cause of the collision has not yet been determined.
