Subject: **FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION – VEHICLE VS PEDESTRIAN – 303 H STREET**

Chula Vista – a woman in her 80's has passed away after being struck by a vehicle in a parking structure.

At approximately 11:40 a.m. today, officers responded to reports of a traffic collision involving a pedestrian in the parking structure at 303 H Street in Chula Vista. When officers arrived, they found a woman in her 80's severely injured in the parking lot. The woman, a resident of Chula Vista, was transported to hospital but was pronounced deceased after arriving. Her identity is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.

Based on the initial investigation, the driver of a pickup truck, a Chula Vista man in his 50's, was rounding a corner in the parking structure when he inadvertently struck the woman with his vehicle. The woman was on foot at the time. The driver remained on scene and has been cooperative with authorities. Drugs, alcohol, and speed are not believed to be factors in the collision at this time.

The Chula Vista Police Department Traffic Bureau responded and are continuing their investigation.
