Guests can also enjoy impactful speakers from both the department and the faith community, admire local lowriders on display, and take plenty of photo opportunities with the CVPD Hot Rod, ATV, and more.

Faith & Blue Weekend is a national event with activities in communities across the country that bring together law enforcement and residents to build connections, create mutual understanding, and enhance justice and reconciliation. "There's not a problem in this country...that we cannot solve if we have the courage to sit together, and reason together, and converse together," says Reverend Markel Hutchins (CEO of MovementForward, Inc. and National Faith & Blue Weekend organizer).

This is the third time the Chula Vista Police Department will be participating in the National Faith & Blue Weekend Event. It's expected to draw over 500 people.
