Original press release information:

On December 28, 2025, at approximately 1:40 a.m., the Chula Vista Police Department Communications Center received a 9-1-1 call from a witness located at 656 E Street in Chula Vista. The caller reported a male had been shot. Officers were on scene within a few minutes and discovered the 31-year-old San Diego man victim suffering from gunshot wounds. Officers administered life-saving measures until paramedics arrived and transported the victim to local hospital where the victim remains in critical condition. The identity of the victim is being withheld at this time.

The investigation is ongoing, and investigators have determined the victim was in the parking lot of a local bar with a group of subjects when he was shot. It is unknown at this time why the shooting occurred. Investigators are currently trying to locate witnesses to this incident.

***UPDATE #1 (JAN. 6th, 2026):**

Although the incident was initially being investigated as an attempt homicide, the victim unfortunately succumbed to his injuries and passed away in the hospital on January 1st. He has been identified as 31-year-old Pablo Hernandez, Jr.

Detectives are still actively investigating the homicide and are seeking to speak with individuals believed to have witnessed the incident or the circumstances leading up to the shooting.
