Message: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On August 11th, 2025 at approximately 7:45 p.m., the Chula Vista Police Department received several calls regarding a 2 vehicle traffic collision in the area of Telegraph Canyon Road and Apache Drive in the city of Chula Vista. Police personnel arrived on scene and discovered a red Ford Mustang traveling west on Telegraph Canyon Road, hit a white Subaru Forester, making a northbound turn on to Apache Drive from eastbound Telegraph Canyon Road. The Subaru Forester overturned, and the four occupants were trapped in the car, needing to be extricated by fire personnel. Witnesses, police and fire personnel rendered life saving measures to the driver of the Forester who was pronounced deceased on scene. The victim is a 75-year-old male from Chula Vista. The 76-year old male front passenger of the Forester was transported to a local trauma center with life threatening injuries and succumbed to his injuries at the hospital. There were two elderly females in the backseat of the Forester who sustained life threatening injuries, however both remain stable at the hospital. The driver of the Mustang (41-year-old male from National City) remained on scene and is cooperative with the investigation. He was transported to the hospital with minor injuries. The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau was called to the scene to investigate the collision.

The names of those involved is being withheld pending notifications. The cause of the collision has not yet been determined. At this time, alcohol and/or drugs is not considered a factor. The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau is currently investigating the collision. ***UPDATE #1 (JAN. 9th, 2026):**

On Thursday, January 8th, 2026, at approximately 3:59 p.m., the Chula Vista Police Department, working in coordination with members of the San Diego Regional Fugitive Task Force, arrested 41-year-old Henry Lagliva (the driver of the Mustang) in connection with the investigation. Lagliva was arrested at his place of work in Chula Vista without incident and later booked into San Diego County Jail pending charges of felony vehicular manslaughter, Penal Code 192(C)(1), and felony reckless driving with specified injuries, Vehicle Code 23105(a).

The victims were previously identified as 62-year-old Michael Baril of Chula Vista (the driver of the Subaru Forester—originally reported as a 75-year-old male from Chula Vista) and 76-year-old Juanito Muyco (the front passenger of the Subaru Forester).
