Chula Vista, Calif. – On January 30th, 2026 the Chula Vista Police Department conducted a driving under the influence (DUI)/Driver's License Checkpoint in the 600 block of Palomar Street, City of Chula Vista from 6 p.m. to 12 a.m. The following are the results:

- 2254 vehicles traveled through the checkpoint
- 678 vehicles were screened
- 2 drivers conducted field sobriety tests
- 6 vehicles were impounded
- 17 unlicensed or suspended license citations were issued
- 23 total citations were issued

DUI checkpoint locations are determined based on reported incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints are to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off roads.

Funding for this checkpoint was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
