Chula Vista, Calif. – On March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026 the Chula Vista Police Department conducted a driving under the influence (DUI)/Driver's License Checkpoint in the 300 block of L Street, City of Chula Vista from 6 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. The following are the results:

- 1056 vehicles traveled through the checkpoint
- 487 vehicles were screened
- 2 drivers conducted field sobriety tests
- 3 vehicles were impounded
- 9 unlicensed or suspended license citations were issued
- 11 total citations were issued

DUI checkpoint locations are determined based on reported incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints are to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off roads.

Funding for this checkpoint was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
